Learned counsel for the State pointed out from the communication dated 09.03.2017 between the Registrar General, Punjab and Haryana High Court and District and Sessions Judge, Gurugram, that petitioner as and when he submitted medical bills, same would be considered by the concerned respondent. In this regard, the Hon'ble Chief Justice was pleased to pass the following order which has been extracted in the communication, which reads as under:-

“It may be ensured that medical bills of the retiree are cleared promptly within a month of submission. However, in the absence of any provision in the Rules for advance payment, the request received from the retiree cannot be accepted”.

In view of the aforesaid communication and the decision, writ petition did not survive and the same stands disposed of reserving liberty to the petitioner that if there is any hurdle in respect of medical reimbursement by the respondent, he is permitted to file a fresh petition.
