Learned counsel for the petitioners herein contends that the issue involved in the instant writ petition is covered by the judgment rendered by this court in *Civil Writ Petition No.2371 of 2010* titled as '*Harbans Lal vs. State of Punjab and others*', decided on 31.08.2010 (Annexure P-8).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners herein seeking the same benefit, served a legal notice dated 27.02.2017 (Annexure P-13) upon the respondents, which is still pending consideration. It is also contended that a resolution has already been taken by respondent No.3 in this regard, which is dated 11.05.2016 (Annexure P-11), which is pending approval with respondent No.2. Learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer that directions may be issued to the respondents to decide legal notice dated 27.02.2017 (Annexure P-13) served by the petitioners upon the respondents as expeditiously as possible.

On the asking of the court Mr. R.S. Sidhu, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Let four copies of the paper book be served upon him during the course of the day.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer, I dispose of the writ petition by directing respondents to decide the legal notice dated 27.02.2017 (Annexure P-13) served by the petitioners upon the respondents as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
