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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was compulsorily retired from service with effect from 3.4.2016, vide order endorsed on 9.1.2016 (Annexure-P-4). The petitioner claims that his gratuity, commutation of pension and arrears of pay have not been released so far. The petitioner has already made a representation dated 27.7.2016 (Annexure-P-5) to respondents. The short prayer made at this stage is to direct respondents to decide the said representation of the petitioner dated 27.7.2016 (Annexure-P-5) in accordance with law.

In these circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 27.7.2016 (Annexure-P-5) and decide the same by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
