The petitioner claims that her land measuring 200 square yard was acquired by State of Punjab for Improvement Trust, Ludhiana in the year 1976. From the averments made in the writ petition it appears that the petitioner was neither paid compensation nor any plot was allotted in her favour under the category of Local Displacement Persons. The petitioner has raked up the stale claim after decades though she is said to have applied to the Improvement Trust on 28.01.1998 (P-3) also.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of relief sought, however without expressing any views on the petitioner's entitlement at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Chairman, Improvement Trust, Ludhiana, to verify the petitioner's claim and if compensation in lieu of acquired land has not been paid, let the same be released to her with interest. Similarly, if the petitioner

is entitled to any other relief as per the Rules, let the same be granted to her

within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
