This petition has been filed for quashing the transfer orders dated 09.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) and relieving orders (Annexure P-2).

I am not inclined to interfere with the transfer orders. In the present case the petitioner has been transferred from Rohtak to Faridabad. However, the learned counsel states that this transfer has been made contrary to the conditions which was specified in the transfer orders. The learned counsel further states that he may be allowed to represent before the respondent no.2 who may be directed to decide his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In case any such representation is moved alongwith certified copy of this order within 15

stands disposed of.

A copy of this order be given dasti to the petitioner on payment of usual charges.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
