KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner claims for counting of military service rendered by him during 1st National Emergency and 2nd National Emergency for the purpose of increment, seniority and pension. The petitioner retired from service on 31.12.2016. The petitioner has already served legal notice dated 25.04.2017 (Annexure P-6).

Short prayer made at this stage is to direct the respondents to decide the legal notice of the petitioner dated 25.04.2017 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.1 to decide the legal notice of the petitioner dated 25.04.2017 (Annexure P-6) within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order.

Since the petitioner retired from service in the year 2006 and the claim has been made in the year 2017, in case, the respondents decide to allow the claim, they shall be at liberty to restrict it to a particular period.
