The petitioner claims that he used to reside in *Jhuggi* in Burail Colony No.5, Sector-45, Chandigarh, which has been demolished by the Chandigarh Administration. The petitioner's further case is that he fulfills all the eligibility conditions prescribed under the 'Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme, 2006' for allotment of one room tenement. He further alleges that his claim has not been considered as per the eligibility criteria explained by this Court in the case of Dinesh Kumar and others versus Union Territory, Chandigarh and others, CWP No.2317 of 2014 decided on 22.12.2014 (P-1).

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of relief sought by him, however without expressing any views on the petitioner's entitlement, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to verify and decide the petitioner's claim by passing a reasoned order in the light of the above-cited decision in Dinesh

Kumar and others' case, within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
