The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking a direction to the respondent-Bank to restore OTS scheme for ₹ 886.00 lacs which was finalized in the Lok Adalat at DRT-I, Chandigarh on 14.02.2015 and further for setting aside the order dated 08.06.2015 (Annexure P-7) passed by the DRT-I, Chandigarh.
