No direction can be issued to decide a legal notice as a matter of right. It is upto the authorities to look at that because legal notice(s) are not statutory. This is not to say that non-statutory representations or legal notices should not be decided within reasonable time in cases of genuine grievances. The petitioner has timed this petition exactly two months from the date of serving a legal notice. There is no impugned order in this petition. Therefore, the jurisdiction of the writ court ought not to be ignited unless there is grave urgency and there is none.

Consequently, the present petition is dismissed as premature.
