Petitioner has questioned the validity of order of termination dated 25.02.2011 (Annexure P1). Petitioner is stated to have been appointed as Ambulance Driver under scheme called National Rural Health Mission (NRHM). When the petitioner was working as a Driver. His services were terminated on 25.02.2011. Between 25.02.2011 till filing of this petition, petitioner has not taken any action either approached the respondents and also asking for order of termination as well as why petitioner's services have been terminated. Petitioner has opened his eyes only as and when case of one Sh. Ravinder Kumar was decided by this court vide CWP No. 19066 of 2014 decided on 01.03.2017. Thus, the petitioner is a fence sitter. Therefore, he is not entitled for any relief. Moreover, there is delay of 6 years in challenging Annexure P1 dated 25.02.2011. Hence petitioner has not made out a case.

CWP stands rejected.
