After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief claimed in this petition the petitioners have also moved a representation dated 30.03.2017 (Annexure P-9) and at this stage they would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioners are entitled to the relief claimed the same be also granted to them within that period.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
