The learned counsel for respondents has stated that the amount has been sanctioned and audited. However, an objection has been raised that the petitioner should file an affidavit that in case of excess payment, he will be liable to refund the same.

The learned counsel for the petitioner at bar states that if any excess amount is found to have been paid due to arithmetical error, the petitioner will refund the same.
