The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of Assured Career Progression (A.C.P.) Scheme to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 01.03.2017 (Annexure P-6) upon the respondents-Department, but the same is pending consideration. Learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer to the extent that the respondents-Department should be directed to decide the said legal notice expeditiously.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and in view of the limited prayer, without going into the merits of the case, I dispose of the

instant writ petition by directing the respondents-Department to decide the legal notice dated 01.03.2017 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioners within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
