The petitioner has approached this Court impugning the order dated Nil (Annexure P-12) endorsed to the petitioner vide letter dated 02.02.2015 vide which the representation filed by the petitioner for release of the land owned by him from acquisition has been rejected. The notifications under Sections 4 and 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 were issued on 07.01.2008 and 06.01.2009, respectively. Award was announced by the Land Acquisition Collector on 04.01.2011. The petitioner claimed that he had constructed some portion of the total plot measuring 220 square yards purchased by him. Though, the portion of land owned by other persons had been released from acquisition, however, the petitioner's land has not been released.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, we do not find any reason to interfere in the present petition. A perusal of the impugned order shows that the land owned by the petitioner falls within the area required for widening of Rohtak-Jhajjar road. The portion of land which the

petitioner is alleging had been released from acquisition is not similarly placed.

As the land owned by the petitioner is required for widening of road, the same cannot be released from acquisition as otherwise the project of widening of road itself will be stalled.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
