By this petition the petitioner has challenged her transfer order
(Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has
also moved a representation dated 16.05.2017 (Annexure P-7) to the
respondent No.2 and at this stage she would be satisfied if a direction is
given to the respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing a speaking order
thereon and to stay the operation of the impugned order till then.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this
petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the
said representation (Annexure P-7) by passing a speaking order thereon and
to maintain status-quo with regard to the place of work of the petitioner as

its exists today.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
