On account of the compelling reason, namely, there being 'non-construction zone' within 100 meter radius of boundary wall of Air Force Station, the Amritsar Improvement Trust has re-conceptualized its 'Ajnala Road Scheme' as a result of which the location of plots earlier allotted to the petitioners has been shifted. While offering the plots at the new location, an option has also been given to them either to accept the new location or seek refund of their amount.

It appears that the petitioners are in double mind. Neither they want to give-up the allotment nor they want shifting of the plots. They are said to have filed objections dated 18.02.2016 and 15.02.2017/14.03.2017 (P-9 & P-10, respectively), against the above-stated offer of the Trust.

In this view of the matter, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Trust authorities to consider and decide the above-stated objections of the petitioner by way of a reasoned order as early as possible

and preferably within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
