The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No. 1 and 2 to promote the petitioner as Head Teacher from the date his respective junior, i.e. respondents No. 3, was promoted to the said post.

The matter came up for hearing on 19.01.2017 when a statement was made by the counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents-State, on instructions from Ms. Surpreet Kaur, Clerk, Education Department, that necessary relief of promotion as sought by the petitioner had been given as far back as 10.10.2016.

On the last date of hearing, no one represented the petitioner and even today, no one is present on his behalf.

Therefore, in view of the statement that has been made, the instant writ petition is disposed of as infructuous giving liberty to the petitioner to revive the same in case any grievance still survives.
