In the instant writ petition, the petitioner has sought for declaration to the respondents permitting to report for duty with reference to order dated 21.10.2014 (Annexure P/8).

It is undisputed that petitioner's selection and appointment to the post of PGT Physics was not in accordance with rules of recruitment to the extent that petitioner did not have the requisite experience qualification. Thus, he was not permitted to report for duty in the month of October 2014. The petitioner got issued legal notice dated 28.06.2016 i.e. after nearly 1-1/2 years.

Having regard to the conduct of the petitioner and the fact that petitioner is ineligible for the post of PGT Physics, present petition do not survive for consideration.

Accordingly, instant writ petition stands dismissed.
