**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)**

Petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of pay scale ₹15600-39100 with Annual Grade Pay of ₹6,000/- with effect from the date the services of the petitioner stands regularised as Assistant Director Physical Education in view of the Notification dated 22.01.2010 (Annexure P-10) issued by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi, and the Punjab Government Notification dated 18.06.2010 (Annexure P-11) which grants the said pay grade to the persons working on the said post as the petitioner. Claiming the same, petitioner had been submitting representations since 14.02.2013 (Annexure P-14) and the last of the said representations is dated 19.09.2014 (Annexure P-15) which have all been recommended by the Principal of the Institute-respondent No.3, where the petitioner is working. Counsel has also referred to the various communications/correspondence which had taken place and the matter having been discussed between the Director, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab, as well as the Principal of the Institute-respondent No.3, marked as Annexures P-16 to P-21. Specific reference has also been made to the final recommendation dated 31.01.2017 (Annexure P-22) by the Principal of the Institute-respondent No.3 to the Director, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training,

Punjab-respondent No.2.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents 1 and 2 consider and decide the representation 19.09.2014 (Annexure P-15) and pass a speaking order within some specified time.

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Principal Secretary, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab-respondent No.1 and The Director, Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab-respondent No.2, to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 19.09.2014 (Annexure P-15) taking into consideration the recommendations made by the Principal of the Institute-respondent No.3, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to him, in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks thereafter. In case the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to him forthwith.
