KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner wants to change his option in view of instructions dated 24.01.2011 (Annexure P-6). He also seeks the benefit of judgment dated 05.10.2015 (Annexure P-15), passed in CWP No.21250 of 2015 titled as “*Dr. Rakesh Sharma vs. State of Punjab and others*”, qua the similarly situated employees.

Petitioner has already made a representation dated 26.11.2015 (Annexure P-16) to the District Ayurvedic and Unani Officer, Hoshiarpur with copies to the Principal Secretary, Health Punjab, Chandigarh and Director, Ayurvedic Punjab, Chandigarh.

The short prayer made at this stage is that the present petition may be disposed of with directions to the respondents to decide the representation dated 26.11.2015 (Annexure P-16) in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 26.11.2015 (Annexure

P-16) and decide the same by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this Court, after considering the case of the similarly situated employees and the judgment dated 05.10.2015 (Annexure P-15) attached with the writ petition.
