Pursuant to the order dated 06.03.2017, the concerned respondent has taken a decision to release provisional pension to the extent of 100% and arrears bills for the remaining 20% provisional pension. The same has been calculated and it is under consideration for the purpose of disbursement. It is learnt that the petitioner has retired from service on 12.10.2009 and the provisional pension is being paid in the year 2017. Therefore, he is entitled for interest on delayed provisional pension.

The concerned respondent is hereby directed to pay interest @ 9% per annum on the delayed provisional pension and disburse the interest amount also. The above exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from today.
