On 25.5.2017, the following order was passed:-

"In this writ petition the claim is that the petitioner was appointed on contract basis since the year 2009. His services were terminated by an order dated 21.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) which was received by him on 08.05.2017. Against that termination order he filed representation (Annexure P-4) on 11.05.2017. Within six days the present writ petition was filed on 17.05.2017. When the petition came up for hearing learned counsel prayed that a direction be issued to the respondents to decide the representation (Annexure P-4).

I put it to learned counsel as to what was the urgency that the writ petition was filed on the 6th day of moving a representation and why he did not advise the client-the petitioner (being a senior advocate) that it would be appropriate to wait for almost four weeks to give an opportunity to the Government to

consider the representation.

Learned counsel stated that this was for the purpose of obtaining a stay of the termination order. When I pointed out to him that he had not even pressed the prayer for stay he stated that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition.

I deem it appropriate to call upon the petitioner to ascertain why he felt the need to file this writ petition only after 6 days of moving the representation.

Let petitioner appear before this Court on 31.05.2017."

Today petitioner is present in the Court and states that he had approached the Court because of his own will and anxiety.

In the circumstances, petition stands dismissed as premature.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stand disposed of.
