By this petition the petitioner is seeking directions to the respondents to release all his due benefits of arrears of Grade Pay.

In my opinion, it would be appropriate if in the first instance the petitioner move a self-contained representation to the respondent No.2 who shall decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months thereafter. In case the petitioner is found entitled to the relief claimed the same be also granted to him within the aforesaid period.

Ordered accordingly. The petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
