The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to count the previous service rendered by the petitioner in Shaheed Bhagat Singh Municipal College, Kotkapura on pensionable post followed by her service in Government College towards pensionary benefits and grant of selection grade in terms of law laid down by this Court in CWP No. 19214 of 2009 decided on 23.08.2011 and upheld in LPA No. 637 of 2012 decided on 06.11.2012.

It comes out that the petitioner has moved a representation dated 20.10.2016 (*Annexure P-15*) before the respondents. Now, the short prayer of the petitioner at this stage is that the respondents may be directed to decide the said representation dated 20.10.2016 (*Annexure P-15*) within a specific time frame.

In the circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2, to consider the representation dated 20.10.2016 (*Annexure P-15*) of the petitioner, in view of the fact that same benefit has already been granted to the similarly

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situated employees by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that if the petitioner is found to be entitled for the benefit as claimed by her, the same shall be released to her forthwith.
