The short grievance of the petitioner is that a Dharmshala of Scheduled Castes Community was constructed on his private land but has been later on demolished. It is alleged that the Gram Panchayat, who is responsible for the illegal construction, is not removing the *malba* from the site. The petitioner has made a compliant to the official-respondents but finding no response, he has rushed to Court by way of the instant writ petition.

Though we are reluctant to entertain this type of writ-petition but having regard to the fact that the petitioner has approached the authorities who have allegedly not redressed his grievance, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the B.D.P.O., Sehna, District Barnala and other respondents to look into the petitioner's grievance within one month from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
