By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the pensionary benefits immediately along with interest as he had been retired from service after attaining the age of superannuation on dated 31.01.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a legal notice dated 20.04.2017 (Annexure P-1) was served upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken by the respondents.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her legal notice dated 20.04.2017 (Annexure P-1) and to decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
