Through instant writ petition, petitioner-Gas Agency operating in the area of Kahanpur, has sought a direction to the official respondents to withdraw the advertisement Annexure P-1 for appointment of LPG distributors in the nearby location on the ground that it is contrary to the unified guidelines for selection of LPG distributors.

In this context, the petitioner has sent a legal notice to the various authorities of Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. raising objection to the effect that a new distributor agency for sale of distributorship of Indane LPG cylinders allotted to respondent No.6 which is hardly at a distance of 60 meters from the distribution office of the petitioner, is in violation of the unified guidelines.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, at this stage, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the Chief General Manager of Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., Jalandhar to consider the factual and legal pleas taken up in legal notice Annexure P-4 and pass a speaking order and intimate the petitioner about the decision

taken on the legal notice, within a period of one month, after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petitioner will supply a certified copy of this order, copy of the writ petition along with Annexure P-4 in the office of Chief General Manager of Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., Jalandhar for compliance of the order within time prescribed.
