This is a petition under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to transfer the vending contract of Smt. Manjit Kaur at Railway Station, Amritsar, in favour of the petitioner.

The petitioner claims that he has filed an application for permission for installation of vending staff of Smt. Manjit Kaur, Annexure P-4 to the Senior D.C. M, Fzr. Division, Ferozpur.

During course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner informs that vide another order dated 20.01.2017, the petitioner has been directed to close the vend. The said order is not part of the present writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to challenge the same.

This petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh petition, in case so advised.
