This petition has been filed for directing the respondents to consider the petitioners for the regularization of their services in view of the scheme dated 07.05.1991 w.e.f. the date since when the vacancies are lying vacant.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioners have also moved a Legal Notice dated 13.06.2016 (Annexure P-11) to the respondents and at this stage they would be satisfied if this legal notice is decided by the respondent No.2 within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. Keeping in view the

plight as portrayed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a

direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice of the petitioners and take necessary action thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
