This petition has been filed for directing the respondents to count daily-wage service of late husband of the petitioner from 01.07.1981 to 26.02.1987 rendered in Store Construction Division, Panipat, from 26.02.1987 to 1990 rendered in Operation Sub Division, Narwana and from 1990 to 30.04.1993 in Operation Sub Division, UHBVNL, Mustafabad in compliance of the undertaking given to this Court in CWP No.19123 of 2010, titled as *Mangal Singh and others vs. UHBVNL and others*, decided on 27.04.2011.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner

respondents and at this stage she would be satisfied if this legal notice is decided by the respondent No.2 within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. Keeping in view the plight as portrayed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice of the petitioner and take necessary action thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
