The instant writ petition has been filed seeking to challenge the provisions set out in advertisement dated 09.11.2015 (Annexure P-1) issued for filling up 3522 posts of ETT Teachers in which upper age limit of 37 years had been fixed ignoring the provisions of the *Punjab State Education Class III (Primary School Cadre) Service Rules, 1997* in which the age limit had been prescribed to be 42 years.

This Court has already gone into the issue in ***CWP No. 315 of 2016*** titled as ***Parminder Kaur and others vs. State of Punjab and others***, decided on 03.04.2017, wherein, it has been held that the age specified in the advertisement is not sustainable and has to be in accordance with the *Punjab State Education Class III (Primary School Cadre) Service Rules, 1997* notified on 11.06.1998, which is 18 to 42 years. The law point as raised in the instant writ petition is no longer *res integra*.

Hence, the present writ petition is allowed in the same terms as in ***CWP No. 315 of 2016 (supra)***.
