This order shall dispose of the aforesaid two writ petitions.

Counsel for respondent No.3-Indian Nursing Council states that as per the resolution dated 29.10.2014 of the Indian Nursing Council, a student can be promoted to next year even if he fails in one or two subjects. The total time period to complete the B.Sc (Nursing) is eight years. The only requirement is that while appearing in the final year exam, there shall be no back-log paper/s.

In this view of the matter, these writ petitions are allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
