The grievance of the petitioner is that he has not been granted the benefits of step up of pay on completion of 14 years of service.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in this regard, a legal notice dated 02.01.2017 (Annexure P-4) has already been served upon the respondents. At the present moment, limited prayer is made that the respondents should be directed to decide the claim as set up in the said legal notice as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer made, without going into the merits of the case, the respondents are hereby directed to decide the claim as set up in the legal notice dated 02.01.2017 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled to the relief as sought by way of this writ petition, the same be granted to him within a period of two months thereafter.

Writ petition stands disposed of.
