The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to pay the remaining amount of ₹5,00,277/- of the death-cum-retiral benefits of the husband of the petitioner including gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund, pensionary benefits alongwith interest.

Learned counsel for the respondent No. 4 has placed on record the written statement on behalf of respondent No. 4 alongwith undertaking of the petitioner stating that all the pensionary benefits in respect of deceased husband of the petitioner have been received by the petitioner therefore she withdraw the present writ petition.

In view of the matter the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. If it is found that wrong information has been supplied by the respondent No. 4, the respondent No. 4 shall be liable for penal action by this Court.
