AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has filed the present petition impugning the order dated 01.09.2016 (Annexure P-4) declining the claim of the petitioner for LTC and HTC for the block years 2008-2011 and 2012-2015.

The ground taken is that the period for which these claims are being raised has already elapsed and at the relevant time the services of the petitioner were not regularized. Though there is some merit in the argument yet now that the respondents have regularized the services of the petitioner w.e.f. 1989 and has given him other benefits therefore, now it does not lie in their mouth to say that the benefit of LTC and HTC could not be granted to him for those years because he was not a regular employee. In my opinion this Court cannot also lose sight of the fact that the claim now being raised is too inconsequential to be gone into by the High Court. Consequently, the petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail any other remedy that may be available as per the law for the redressal of his grievance.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc.
Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
