The petitioner has challenged the official respondents' decision for having considered its bid to be non-responsive on the ground that the documentation was not in order.

2. It is not necessary for us to decide this question. The petitioner's rate in any event is not as competitive as that of another bidder. Thus, even if the petitioner's bid is found to be responsive, it would make no difference as the 3rd respondent's rate is more competitive.

3. The petition is, therefore, dismissed.

4. It is clarified that the issues relating to the disqualification on other grounds are kept open.
