The petitioner challenges the action of the respondent vide which she has been treated as a seasonal employee.

Counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 has placed on record photocopy of the order dated 27.09.2017, whereby the Managing Director of respondent No.3 has directed that the petitioner would be regularized as and when the post of Peon become available w.e.f. 01.02.2018. The relevant part of the order reads as under:-

“In view of the facts mentioned above, it is hereby ordered that the services of Smt. Kamla Devi, Mill Bed Coolie (seasonal permanent) will be regularized as Peon as and when the post of Peon will be available for General Category and approval of the Mills' Board. The post of Peon for General Category will be available with effect from 1-2-2018 on account of superannuation of Sh. Sodi Singh, Peon on 31.01.2018. Office Supdt. is directed to put the case before the Board of Directors in its next meeting.”

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Keeping in view the above proposal, counsel for the petitioner does not press the present writ petition and is satisfied with proposed line of the action, which is likely to be taken.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as not pressed, in view of the above proposal, binding down the respondents with the same.
