DAG, Haryana accepted notice on their behalf.

The petitioner has Challenged a notice dated May 19, 2017, directing it to deposit the amount of about ₹12.5 crores. The notice itself states that the amount is due against M/s Bestways Transport India Pvt. Ltd. The petitioner contends that the liability of M/s Bestways Transport India Pvt. Ltd. cannot be foisted on it despite the fact that the Directors of the two companies are common as each is a separate legal entity. The petitioner has not even replied to the letter dated 19.5.2017 and has rushed to the Court. The record does not even indicate any coercive steps taken by the

respondents against the petitioner at this stage. The petitioner must in the first instance reply to the letter dated 19.5.2017 and await a response to the same.

The petition is disposed of with liberty aforesaid.
