The petitioner was allotted Plot No.2392, measuring 1 kanal in Sector 57, Urban Estate, Gurugram and allotment letter was issued to him on 20.04.2009. It appears that the land where plot is carved out is under litigation due to which physical possession of the plot could not given to him. It further appears that petitioner was later on allotted Plot No.1375 in Sector 51, Urban Estate, Gurugram in lieu of the aforesaid plot No.2392 but possession of 2nd plot has also not been delivered. The petitioner in these circumstances seeks allotment of an alternative plot. It is further alleged that some of the allottees have been given alternative plots in other sectors. On this plea, the petitioner claims that plot Nos.197 & 193 in Sector 28 and plot No.601 in Sector-43, Gurugram may be allotted to him.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of prayer made in this writ petition, we dispose of the same with a direction to the Chief Administrator, HUDA, Panchkula and the Estate Officer concerned, Gurugram, to entertain the petitioner's grievance and if it is a fact that the authorities are unable to deliver possession of Plot

undisputed alternative plot including those referred to above, be considered within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.

Meanwhile, no third party rights shall be created in respect of plot Nos.197 & 193 in Sector-28 and Plot No.601 in Sector-43, Gurugram.
