The petitioners failed to comply with order dated 13.05.2016. A relevant extract from order dated 13.05.2016 reads as follows:-

“The petitioners have failed to comply with order dated 22.3.2016 despite an order that failure of the petitioners to comply with the order would entail dismissal of the petition. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners despite the case being called thrice and a representative of the petitioners appear before the court at 3.30 p.m.

Counsel prays for another opportunity to comply with order dated 22.3.2016.

In the interest of justice, another opportunity is provided to the petitioners to comply with order dated 22.3.2016 failing which the consequences as recorded in order dated 22.3.2016 would ensue.”

Finding no alternative, the petition is ordered to be dismissed.
