By this petition the petitioners has prayed for to release the salary to them on the basic pay of Rs. 16,290/- w.e.f. 1.1.2006 with all consequential benefits and further directions to the respondents to release the arrear of the salary with effect from 1.1.2006 till final realizations alongiwith interest as the persons appointed after the petitioner is being given on the basic pay of Rs. 16,290/- as pe Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 scale.

To support the aforesaid claim, the learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the judgment of this Court in the matter of Neelam Rani vs. State of Hayana and others, passed in CWP No. 11254 of 2010 decided on 15.05.2013. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a Representation dated 24.01.2012 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.3 and at this stage they would be satisfied if this representation is decided by the respondent

No.3 within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. Keeping in view the plight as portrayed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the said representation of the petitioner and pass a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stand disposed of._
