In the instant petition, the petitioner has questioned the validity of Annexure P-12 by which petitioner has been denied the documents namely enrolment form and original or certified copy of “Graduate Degree/BA Certificate”.

Petitioner's demand relating to above documents is with respect to the holding of an inquiry against him. Perusal of the list of documents, it is evident that documents i.e. Enrolment form and Original or certified copy of “Graduate Degree/BA Certificate are not part and parcel of list of documents enclosed alongwith the charge-memo. In other words, Inquiry officer or disciplinary authority are not relying on enrolment form and Original or certified copy of “Graduate Degree/BA Certificate in the inquiry proceedings so as to furnish those documents to the petitioner. Therefore, the petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with Annexure P-12 dated 9.5.2017.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the

petitioner to make necessary reply to the second show cause notice if the same is issued to the petitioner by the disciplinary authority. Disciplinary authority is hereby directed to consider each of the contention raised by the petitioner against second show cause notice and proceed to pass final order.
