The instant writ petition has been filed with a prayer to grant service benefits that had accrued to the petitioner from time to time as well as to grant promotion, to which the petitioner was entitled.

In brief, the facts are that the petitioner was appointed on ad hoc basis as Helper Electrician in the year 1983 and thereafter, services of the petitioner were regularized on 13.05.1989. The petitioner has retired on 29.02.2016, on attaining the age of superannuation. The petitioner is seeking the benefit of increments and promotions that had been given to similarly situated persons.

At the present moment, learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer that the petitioner has already approached the department

concerned vide representation dated 06.01.2017 (Annexure P-3) which is pending consideration and the same be decided expeditiously.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer, without going into the merits of the case, I dispose of the instant writ petition by directing the respondents-Department to decide the representation dated 06.01.2017 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
