The petitioner has not been given appointment letter despite he being fit to be appointed as a Constable in Punjab Police on the ground that an FIR No.124 dated 08.07.2016 under Section 323, 325, 506, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code stood registered against him at Police Station, Mukerian. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been declared innocent in the said FIR, as such he has got clean record.

The petitioner has submitted representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankot Annexure P-7 dated 05.04.2017 for seeking issuance of appointment letter.

Without expression any opinion on merits, the petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction that the facts and circumstances mentioned in the representation Annexure P-7 will be considered by Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot within a period of two months after the receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order, which would be communicated to the petitioner.
