Rakesh Kumar Jain, J.

The petitioner is an Ex-Serviceman in-service PCMS doctor who had appeared in the counselling conducted by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot on 13/14.04.2017 for admission in the post-graduate medical courses for the session 2017-20. It is alleged that the petitioner had filled up the form provided by the Counselling Committee and opted for a seat in MD (Radio Diagnosis). However, he was not considered for the said seat because he failed to produce the No Objection Certificate issued by the Competent Authority. The petitioner, thus, informed the Counselling Committee that he may be considered in Handicapped Category for the only seat of MD (General Medicine) available at Shri Guru Ram Dass University of Health Sciences, Amritsar. However, the petitioner was offered the seat in MS (Orthopedic) in Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot. The said seat was taken by the petitioner and he deposited the fee etc. but now the present petition has been filed for the purpose of seeking his seat in MD (Radio

Diagnosis) at Guru Gobind Medical College, Amritsar.

The petitioner has approached this Court today when the counselling was going on. There is hardly any time left with this Court even to seek response of the respondents and to clarify the facts.

Thus, in view of these facts and circumstances, I do not find any reason to interfere in the present petition and hence, the same is hereby dismissed.
