The grievance of the petitioner is that he had constructed a cattle shed within the revenue estate of village Khuda Ali Sher, U.T. Chandigarh, after seeking prior permission from the authorities of Chandigarh Administration, which he has been using only for agricultural purposes. The said cattle shed has been demolished by the Land Acquisition Officer, Chandigarh, vide order dated 07.02.2017 in exercise of powers of Deputy Commissioner, Chandigarh under the Punjab New Capital (Periphery) Control Act, 1952. The petitioner has submitted an appeal-cum-representation against the said action of the Land Acquisition Officer, before the Home Secretary-cum-Appellate Authority, U.T. Chandigarh, under the 1952 Act. A copy of the appeal-cum-representation has been appended as Annexure P-19 followed by reminder dated 29.03.2017 (P-21).

In this view of the matter and without expressing any views on merits, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Home Secretary-cum-Appellate Authority, U.T. Chandigarh to decide the petitioner's appeal-cum-representation by way of a reasoned order and after

giving him opportunity of personal hearing, within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
