The petitioner has challenged the chargesheet dated 1.9.2014 (Annexure-P-6), supplementary chargesheet dated 8.1.2015 (Annexure-P-8), inquiry report dated 8.6.2016 (Annexure-P-13), order of punishment dated 7.9.2016 (Annexure-P-15) and the order dated 24.1.2017 (Annexure-P-17), passed by the appellate authority, vide which the petitioner has been awarded major penalty of reduction to a lower post i.e. from Assistant Manager (Scale-I) to office Assistant (Multipurpose).

After going through the chargesheet, supplementary chargesheets, replies and the inquiry report, I am of the view that in this case, the evidence is required to be led and certain facts are required to be established, which cannot be done in the exercise of writ jurisdiction. Therefore, the petitioner is relegated to avail the remedy before the civil court.

In view of the matter, the present writ petition is disposed of.
