In this petition, the petitioner has challenged the action of the respondent whereby OMR sheets submitted by them was not marked because there were erasure/scratches on the same.

Counsel for the petitioner states that present petition may be disposed of in terms of Annexure P-6 since that was similar a case where the Single Judge had dismissed the petition on merits and the Division Bench also dismissed the appeal but gave a direction to respondents to consider the claim of that petitioner sympathetically since he had made representation.

In my opinion the present petition is not covered by the facts of that case (Annexure P-6). I find no merit in this civil writ petition.

Consequently, petition stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil
miscellaneous application, if any, also stand disposed of.
