Learned counsel for respondent No. 4 has produced an office order dated 10.11.2017 passed by the Registrar, Haryana Medical Council vide which the complaint dated 26.12.2013, filed by the petitioner, has been rejected informing him that he can file the statutory appeal against the said order to Medical Council of India under Clause 8.8 of the Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics) Regulations, 2002 framed under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of present petition with liberty to avail the remedy available to him at the first instance by way of filing appeal before the Medical Council of India against the aforesaid order.
