Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the matter has been compromised between the petitioners being the sons of Mahinder Singh and respondent No.3-Khajan Singh son of Jhanda Singh.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has filed the affidavit of Khajan Singh, who is present in Court and identified by Mr. Vikram Satpal Anand, to this effect. In paragraph No.5 of the said affidavit, which reads as under:-

"5. That now the deponent has no objection if the CWP No.15961 of 2015 filed by my grandsons Gurdeep Singh & Gurdev Singh sons of Mohinder Singh be allowed and I have also no objection if the order dated 16.06.2016 be set aside and the transfer deed i.e. Vasika No.129 dated 14.05.2015 be

restored in the name of my grandsons Gurdeep Singh & Gurdev Singh i.e. the petitioners in the present Civil Writ Petition."

he submits that he has no objection in case the impugned order dated 16.06.2016 be set aside and the transfer deed i.e. Vasika No.129 dated 14.05.2015 be restored.

The said affidavit is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, the impugned order dated 16.06.2016 is hereby set aside and the transfer deed i.e. Vasika No.129 dated 14.05.2015 is ordered to be restored in the name of the petitioner(s) being grandsons of Khajan Singh.

With the aforesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
